

## MINISTRIES AT ST. PIUS X - 2018-2019

### LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

- o Training is provided
- o Commitment is 1 - 2 Masses per month

**Altar Server:** Assist the priest during Mass, must be grade 3 or older.

**Audio/Visual:** Operate audio-visual equipment during Masses and special events (sound board & power point).

**Children's Liturgy\*\*\*:** Lead or assist the leader in presenting the gospel to children either ages 4 to 7 or 7 to 12 with age appropriate activities including crafts, songs, videos, stories, puzzles, skits, etc. Adults & teens are welcome to volunteer. Time commitment- you sign up on-line for the dates and times that you can assist.

**Choir:** Provide instrumental and vocal music to enrich our Liturgy Practice 2 hours per week.

**Collection Counter:** Count collections from weekend Masses, on Sunday morning, working in teams of 2 or 3.

**Eucharistic Minister** (must be confirmed): Assist with distribution of communion during Mass.

**Lector** (must be confirmed): Proclaim the Word of God during Mass.

**Mass Steward.** (weekday or weekend mass): Prepare the church for Mass and ensure all ministers of the liturgy are present.

**Preparation of the Gifts** (Families welcome): Bring gifts to the Altar in the (Offertory) Procession. No training is required.

**Usher:** Pass the Collection basket, regulate the flow of Communion traffic, and distribute bulletins after Mass.

### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

**Infant Baptism Preparation:** Instruct expecting and new parents about Baptism (once/month except July & August).

**Marriage Preparation Sponsor Couple:** Become a sponsor couple working with engaged couples.

**Children's Sacramental Preparation\*\*\*:**

First Eucharist, Reconciliation, Confirmation  
Assist the Pastoral Assistant during classes.

No preparation is required. Time Commitment - 2 hours per session for the dates and times that you can assist.

**Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults:** Assist in the instruction of those wishing to become Catholic. Sponsor a new Catholic in learning the faith or help in teaching (Catechist).

### PARISH MINISTRIES

**Building and Maintenance:** Recommend and oversee planned maintenance for Church and Hall. One meeting per month plus some minor maintenance, eg changing light bulbs, repairing kneelers.

**Finance Council:** Oversee financial concerns and parish budget. 3 meetings per year.

**Funeral Ministry:** When there is a funeral, we are often in need of a Mass Steward, Music Ministry and/or an A/V person. Please consider volunteering for this essential ministry.

**Garden Committee:** Assist with planting, watering & maintaining Parish gardens during summer months. Also some watering of the lawn. No meetings.

**Grocery Card Fundraiser:** Sell grocery gift cards after weekend Masses, 1 mass per month.

**NEW - Indoor Plant & Candle Maintenance:** Assist Pastoral Assistant in maintaining plants and candles in the church, as requested throughout the year.

**Linen Care:** Launder, press & fold Church linens; once every 6 weeks.

**Liturgical Environment:** Assist with decorating the church and/or hall for special events, such as Easter or Christmas. 1-2 hours per event.

**Liturgy Committee:** Explore ideas for enriching and planning liturgies. 1 meeting per month.

**Office Help:** Assist in Parish office: photocopying, data entry, filing, etc.

**Parish Council:** Guide our Church in creating a thriving parish. 1 meeting per month.

**NEW - Pastoral Assistant Help:** Assist in Pastoral Office with photo copying, organization and children's program preparation.

**Pew Cleaners:** Dust & tidy pews and Sacristy, with the occasional cleaning. Approx 2 hours per month.

**Together in Action:** Assist with stuffing envelopes for the annual TIA campaign. One Saturday morning.

**Website:** Updating and maintaining the Parish website and social media.



### HOSPITALITY MINISTRIES

**Hospitality Committee:** Coordinate greeters and welcome people.

**Greeter:** Greet visitors and Parishioners as they come into church at Mass.

**Welcoming People:** Contact new Parishioners and tell them about our Parish.

### SOCIAL MINISTRIES

**Reception Assistant:** Assist with Parish receptions (setup, clean up, or serve), as needed.

**Pot Luck Meal Host:** Organize one of 5 potluck meals during the year, after 5 PM Saturday Mass.

**Social Events Committee:** Assist with one or more of our Parish social events, eg Stampede breakfast.

**Sunday Coffee Host:** Prepare and serve coffee after both Sunday morning Masses. Cookies and coffee supplied by the Parish. Baking is optional.

### SERVICE AND OUTREACH

**Catholic Women's League:** Provides women 16 years and up, the opportunity to share faith, give service and have fun together. 8 meetings per year.

**Food Bank:** Monitor food basket collection and deliver Parish food donations to the Food Bank. (1 - 2 times per year).

**Knights of Columbus:** Catholic Men's group called to Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. 1 meeting per month.

**Manna Ministry:** Collect and deliver sandwiches monthly and toiletries to agencies working with homeless and poor; prepare and serve two meals yearly to the Mustard Seed clients, 2 meetings per year.

**St. Rita's Women's Group:** Serving at funeral receptions and fundraisers for various projects while enjoying the fellowship of our members, monthly meeting.

**St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP)\*\*\*:** Service to the poor (delivering food hampers) & Christmas hampers. Meets 2 times per month on Tuesday evenings.

**SVdP Christmas Hamper:** Assist with packaging and/or delivering Christmas hampers in December.



**Pastoral Health Care\*\*\*:**

- o Bring Sunday communion to residents at Bethany Care Centre, after 9 AM Sunday Mass.
- o Visit the sick and elderly in their homes.
- o Assist at Bethany Care Centre on Thursday mornings bringing residents from their rooms to 10:30 AM Mass.

### PRAYER & FAITH

**Adult Faith Formation:** Are you interested in leading a Faith Group or just joining one? Please join us.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** Prayer Thursdays 6 - 7 PM, after 5:30 Mass.

**Legion of Mary:** Devotion to Mary, Tuesdays, 9:15 AM.

**Men's Prayer and Discussion Group:** Meets one Monday evening a month.

**Ministry of Praise:** Daily prayers at home for those who are sick, deceased or other intentions.

**Spiritual Dimension of Women:** Faith sharing with other women. Friday mornings, 9:30 - 10:30 AM

**Young Adult Group:** "Bring Your Own Bible" (BYOB), for ages 20-35 who want to find friends in faith. Join us for social events and faith discovery sessions.

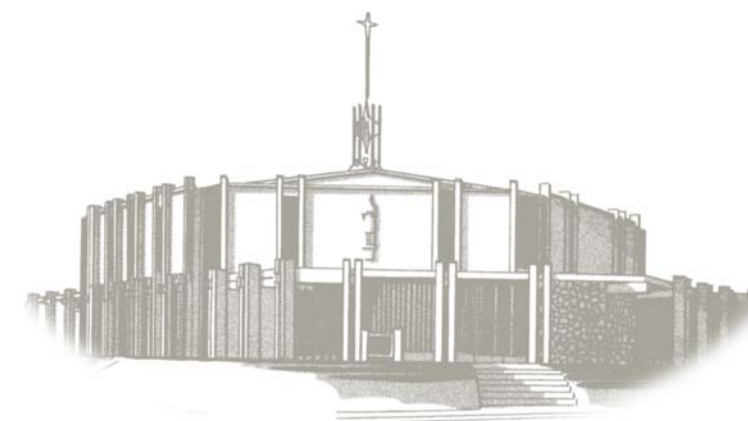
